As mentioned in the meeting we had on Tuesday, I've attached 3 documents here. Two Lexicon documents and the CRCL Principles document.

The 2015 DHS DT HVE Lexicon contains all the definitions we use and include in all of our products to make sure that everyone is working from the same starting points when discussing DT and HVE. It's a way to keep the language used by DHS consistent and precise. It's getting a little old, and a new Lexicon is in development, but this is still what DHS uses....

UNLESS... the term is found in the Interim Guidance Memo from March 2021. Terms in the memo supersede terms in the 2015 Lexicon.

The other document included is the memo on CRCL Principles for Intelligence Analysis. Although it is targeted at Intel Analysis, these principle are applicable to all DHS work. We use them daily here, in fact, I keep a printed version on my desk at all times.
