

FPS has a single protected facility in Kenosha – the SSA at 5624 6th Ave. This facility is approximately .3 mile from the Kenosha Courthouse and the locus of the rioting. This facility is reportedly CLOSING permanently on Friday, with SSA moving to their new facility at 3915 30th Ave. (we have reached out to SSA to confirm if this schedule has been impacted by the current events – I will update once we have that conversation). The new facility is approximately 1.6 miles from the Kenosha Courthouse (2.5 miles by vehicle).

The current SSA location is closed and all windows/entrances boarded up. We do not have any new damage reports.



Good morning, the front Office is requesting information on the federal footprint in Kenosha, WI. From what I understand there is a SSA Office and a Post Office in town and no FPS LEOs are permanently assigned there.

Could you all please verify the number of Federal facilities in Kenosha and also provide the following:
