GOP CASUALTY STATISTICS

5. (U) Major General Athar Abbas, the military's chief spokesman, went over casualty statistics in a June 11 press conference. According to Abbas, 1700 Pakistan troops have been killed in the counter terrorism struggle since September 11, 2001. He put the toll over the past year at over 600 and of the ongoing Swat operation at 110. Abbas said that the military is operating on six fronts: South Waziristan, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Kurram and Swat. He attributed the steep rise in troop casualties to the broad front against the militants. Regarding enemy casualties, Abbas said that over 8000 have been killed since September 2001, 1350 of those during the Swat operation. He also said that 5,000 innocent Pakistanis have fallen victim to terrorist attacks since 2001. Abbas counted 169 suicide attacks in that time. Abbas said that American aid has been disbursed at the rate of USD 500 million per year, but that figure will go up to USD 1.5 billion upon passage of the Kerry-Lugar bill. Finally, MG Abbas said that U.S. drone attacks that "challenge the sovereignty of Pakistan" exceed 39 and have resulted in 450 deaths.
