46. (SBU) Pakistan - Al-Qa, ida plotters allegedly killed in U.S. air strike: Two al-Qa, ida operatives, including the alleged mastermind of the 2006 transatlantic airplane bombing plot, were killed in a U.S. missile strike in North Waziristan early Saturday, November 22, according to open sources. Al-Qa, ida leaders Abu-al-Misri and Rashid Rauf were reportedly killed in the attack. Rashid Rauf had escaped in December 2007 from Pakistani police custody, according to one press account. He reportedly had been on his way to an extradition hearing after Britain had requested the move. Al-Qa, ida has long pledged to retaliate for such attacks.
