



Mass Evacuation Traffic Plan

The Milwaukee Urban Area Security Initiative and Wisconsin Emergency Management have developed the Southeast Region Mass Evacuation Plan. The Department has developed a Mass Evacuation Traffic Plan to address our responsibilities under the Southeast regional plan.

The Glendale PD Mass Evacuation Traffic Plan and the Southeast Region Mass Evacuation Plan are in a binder located in the Sergeant's Office.

Brief Overview:

The plan provides for evacuation routes and relocation centers in the event of a major incident that requires the evacuation of a significant number of people from downtown Milwaukee. The northern evacuation route is the N/B I-43 corridor.

Should this plan be activated N/B I-43 would remain open as an evacuation route, S/B I-43 will be closed at Brown Deer Road. The S/B I-43 lanes will be designated for 2-way

traffic; N/B traffic will be reserved for Milwaukee County Transit buses evacuating people to the reception center at Nicolet High School, S/B traffic will be reserved for emergency vehicles and return bus route. The Red Cross will operate a relocation center at Nicolet High School. Persons who live north of Milwaukee who are unable to evacuate themselves will be directed to an assembly area in the downtown Milwaukee area and evacuated by bus to the NHS reception center where they can be reunited with family members. Our responsibilities will be to close the on-ramps for S/B I-43 and provide traffic control for evacuation buses to NHS. Bus route will exit at Good Hope and continue via Port Washington, Green Tree and Jean Nicolet.
