#### NARRATIVE

On 08-23-20 at approximately 10:00PM I, Det. J. Sielski #243 along with Det. T. Barnett #160 assisted Wisconsin Department of Justice - Division of Criminal Investigation Special Agents with evidence related to a Kenosha Police Officer involved shooting (KSD Case #20-332547). While logging and turning over evidence in the Detective Bureau Conference room we heard a large crowd of people yelling and throwing things at the Public Safety Building. We heard a loud "bang" sound near a second floor window which faces the front of the PSB (south). The window shades were drawn and the lights were off at the time. I went to the window and began hearing cracking sounds. We later examined the extent of the damage which consisted of a baseball sized hole in the outside pane of the double paned, tempered glass window as well as extensive cracks through the entire outer pane. The inside pane remained intact. The window is located in the sensitive crimes office area of the KSD Detective Bureau. We did not observe who threw the item or what actually broke the window. I took photographs of the damage and logged them into the DIMs system for records.
