NARRATIVE

On 08/23/2020 at approximately 6:00 PM the Kenosha County Tactical Response Team (TRT) was requested to assist the City of Kenosha Police Department (KPD) in reference to a reported officer involved shooting. This incident occurred under KPD Case #2020-46498. A major incident of civil unrest/rioting occurred in correlation to the officer involved shooting. During the course of the assistance provided to the KPD, vehicles owned by the Kenosha County Sheriff's Department, and operated by TRT members suffered damage. The following is a description of the vehicles utilized, damaged sustained and Team Leaders (TL's) assigned to each vehicle. Due to the magnitude of the situation, it is unclear at what specific time the damage occurred and no suspects are known at this time. The damage was caused at some point in time during the civil unrest/rioting which occurred on 08/23/2020, 08/24/2020, and 08/25/2020.

KSD Squad #533

This vehicle is a fully marked Ford F250 which bears WI municipal registration. During the time damage occurred, it was manned by KPD Detective and TL B. Wilson #533. This vehicle was utilized to respond to an officer who had been struck by a brick and sustained injury on 08/23/2020. During the response to this incident, the vehicle was struck numerous times by heavy debris items (rocks, bricks, bottles, and other flying debris). This initial damage occurred in the 4400 block of 28th Ave. The vehicle was also utilized to support crowd control in the 5800 block of Sheridan Rd/STH 32. During the course of this support, the pickup was also struck again with heavy flying debris which caused additional damage. The driver's side rear passenger window and rear truck cap window were shattered during these incidents. The vehicle also sustained numerous dents and paint damage due to the debris being thrown at the vehicle. That damage is primarily on the driver's side of the vehicle from front to back and also on the tailgate. It is unknown at this time the monetary value of the damage caused to this vehicle. Photographs of the vehicle damage were obtained and later logged into PSB Evidence under KSD Cs#2020-333512.

KSD Squad #534

This vehicle is also a fully marked Ford F250 which bears WI municipal registration During the time damage occurred it was manned by KSD Detective and Assistant TL J. Scifres # 257. This vehicle was also utilized to support law enforcement which responded to the officer

involved shooting scene/assault on an officer in the 4000 block of 28th Ave. This vehicle also suffered damage from rocks, bricks, bottles and other heavy debris items. The damage occurred on 08/23/2020 at some point in time while responding to the incident scene. The truck bed cap rear window was shattered during this time. The vehicle also suffered paint damage and dents caused by the flying debris. The tail gate and truck bed cap suffered the bulk of the damage. It is unknown at this time the monetary value of the damage sustained to this vehicle. I obtained photographs of the damage suffered to this vehicle and later placed the photographs onto a disc and logged it into PSB Evidence under KSD Cs#2020-333513.

KSD MRAP #317

This vehicle is a fully marked International armored personnel carrier and it bears WI The MRAP was manned by TRT TL and KPD Sqt. T. Zukauskas # municipal registration 550. The MRAP was utilized to support elements of the TRT and Kenosha County Crowd Control Team on 08/24/2020 in front of the Kenosha County Court House (912-56th St.). At the time the MRAP was utilized, a crowd numbering in the several hundred's had become violent and was throwing heavy debris items, firework mortars, and other objects at crowd control teams present. The MRAP was brought in to support two Bearcats, one of which had become immobilized due to an explosive device detonating near it. Once the MRAP was able to support the elements removing the bearcats, it took position on the southeast corner of the courthouse. During this time, the MRAP sustained damage. The front windows sustained damage from debris items thrown at it. The front grill and bumper also sustained similar damage from debris. The one headlight was broken and the rest were spray painted. The vehicle also sustained damage to the driver's side from debris thrown at it. It is unknown at this time the monetary value of the damage caused to this vehicle. I obtained photographs of the vehicle's damage and later placed them onto a disc. I logged these photographs under KSD Cs#2020-333514.

KSD Bearcat #535

This vehicle is a fully marked armored personnel carrier and it bears WI municipal registration E2368. I manned the Bearcat as the TL. On 08/23/2020 the Bearcat was requested to respond to the officer down call for assistance at the initial shooting scene. The Bearcat was utilized to transport the injured KPD officer away from the scene. During this time, the vehicle was

struck by heavy debris items. On 08/24/2020 the Bearcat was utilized to support crowd control elements stationed in front of the Kenosha County Courthouse and in front of the Kenosha Public Safety Building (PSB) (1000-55th St.). Upon initial deployment to the PSB, the Bearcat was surrounded by a large crowd of persons in its efforts to support those patrol deputies stationed in front of the PSB. At that time, an unknown subject located within the crowd on the west side of 10th Ave. north of 56th St. fired rounds from a handgun at the Bearcat. The Bearcat was struck on one of the rear passenger side windows by a round fired. This round caused damage to the entirety of the window. Once the front of the PSB was secure, the Bearcat was repositioned in front of the Kenosha County Courthouse on 56th St. This was done to support elements of crowd control stationed there. During this time, the Bearcat was struck by several heavy debris items as well as firework mortars thrown at it. Numerous paint damage was caused to the front of the vehicle. The front window also sustained damage from an unknown object. I obtained photographs of this damage, placed them onto a disc, and logged them into PSB Evidence. Those photographs were logged under KSD Cs#2020-333515.

I completed reports for the above listed damage to each vehicle under the corresponding case number assigned to the photographs obtained. The following is a list of those reports for cross-referencing purposes:
