**NARRATIVE**

On August 23, 2020 at 1717 hours, I Deputy George #315 was dispatched to assist the City of Kenosha Police Department with an officer involved shooting in the 4500 block of 28<sup>th</sup> Avenue. I arrived on the scene at 1720 hours and parked my squad in the 4400 block of 28<sup>th</sup> Avenue. I observed KPD Officers placing crime scene tape as well as other KPD Officers providing what appeared to be life saving measures to a male. This male was lying on the ground near the partially open driver's side door of an SUV. This SUV was parked on the west side of 28<sup>th</sup> Avenue and bearing Oklahoma registration plate IVJ935.

I positioned myself within the crime scene tape on the northeast corner of the scene and maintained this position until the male was moved into an ambulance. Shortly after the male was placed into an ambulance, I took a position in the center of 28<sup>th</sup> Avenue securing the immediate area around the SUV. While I stood guard over the SUV no one entered, touched, or tampered with it. Additionally, the items lying on the ground nearby as well as the pool of what appeared to be blood were not touched or tampered with. I observed a small folded pile of what appeared to be paper money in varying denominations on the ground just under the driver's side passenger door frame. Throughout the evening as the wind picked up this money began to blow and distribute towards the rear of the car and the street behind it. This money was not touched or tampered with.

At an unknown time during the evening, Officer Weidner #431 photographed the SUV but did not touch or tamper with it or the surrounding evidence in any way. No other Officer or personnel approached the vehicle until Deputy Eckert #203 began photographing the scene much later.

Around 1900 hours, I was joined by WI State Patrol Trooper Lawson #223 who assisted in securing the SUV and the area immediately around it. Until the scene was turned over to KSD Detectives and DCI, either Trooper Lawson, myself, or both of us, remained in close proximity to and maintained a visual of the SUV and the area immediately surrounding it.

On 8/23/2020 at approximately 1742 hours I, Deputy Matson #345, was requested to assist KPD officers with crowd control at an officer involved shooting scene near the intersection of 28th Ave and 40th Street. Upon my arrival on scene I was instructed to report to Froedtert South-Kenosha Hospital (KMH) to wait with a witness, Tamara Booker, in ER Room #8 until the Wisconsin Department of Justice Division of Criminal Investigation (DCI) arrived to conduct an interview.

At the hospital, I made contact with KPD Officer A. Franco #646 who had been waiting with Tamara prior to my arrival. Officer Franco left the hospital and I stood by awaiting the arrival of DCI. Only medical staff and Kenosha County Crisis workers were permitted to enter the room. Crisis advised they were only speaking with Tamara regarding her children.

DCI Special Agent Ricardo Tijerino arrived and conducted an interview while I stood by. Upon the completion of the interview, Special Agent Tijerino advised he no longer needed my assistance.

I cleared taking no further action.

**NARRATIVE**

On 08-23-20 at approximately 6:15 PM I, Det. J. Sielski #243 was requested to respond to the 4000 block of 28<sup>th</sup> street to assist Kenosha Police in a shooting incident. Upon arrival I was requested to assist special agents from the Wisconsin Department of Justice-Division of Criminal Investigation (DCI) who would be taking over the investigation.

Initial information given to me was Kenosha Police Officers were called to 2805 40<sup>th</sup> Ave for a domestic violence incident and an officer shot a subject near the front seat of a grey Dodge Journey. I was advised the subject was armed with a knife.

Det. T. Barnett #160 responded to assist as well. Det. Barnett took scene photographs. The scene consisted of a grey Dodge Journey SUV parked facing south on 28<sup>th</sup> Ave just south of 40<sup>th</sup> Street. The vehicle's front driver and passenger doors were open as well as the rear passenger door. A 9mm cartridge casing and a projectile were observed on the pavement. Several other cartridge casings were found on the grass parkway just west of the vehicle. Evidence of at least two taser deployments were also present with prongs and wire on the roadway. The scene was marked with an outer perimeter with yellow tape and an inner perimeter with red tape. A very large crowd of onlookers were present behind the tape which grew larger and larger the longer the scene was held.

DCI Special Agent Ricardo Tijerino responded to the scene and requested Det. Barnett and I mark and collect scene evidence and turn it over to DCI Special Agent Nick Gates.

Det. Barnett, and I as well as Dep. R. Eckert #203 collected the evidence from the scene. See Det. Barnett's report for further details regarding individual evidence. Det. Barnett pointed out a grey knife on the driver's side floor. We did not collect the knife but instead marked and photographed it. The knife was secured in the vehicle for further processing by DCI.

The vehicle was removed from the scene by Jensen's towing and transported to the Sheriff's Department secure evidence towing facility. Dep. Eckert followed Jensen's towing and secured the vehicle indoors. We were advised DCI Special Agents planned to execute a search warrant to collect the knife and examine the vehicle for further evidence.

I transported the collected evidence to the Sheriff's Department Detective Bureau where Det Barnett and I along with DCI agents logged the collected evidence. All evidence collected was turned over to SA Gates.

**NARRATIVE**

On 08/23/20 at approximately 6:30 PM I, Detective Troy Barnett, was called in to respond to assist KPD and the Wisconsin Department of Justice-Division of Criminal Investigation (DCI) for an officer involved shooting investigation in the 4000 block of 28<sup>th</sup> Ave.

Upon my arrival, I met with Detective Sielski, Detective Bliss and KPD Capt. Hamm who were already on scene. I was advised a KPD officer shot a suspect armed with a knife at the driver's door of a grey 2020 Dodge Journey with Oklahoma registration of IVJ935 which was parked at the west curb of 28<sup>th</sup> Ave facing south approximately 100 feet south of 40<sup>th</sup> Street.

Detective Sielski and I were assigned to process the scene and collect evidence at the request of DCI who were still en route to the scene. I was advised that KSD would collect the evidence with assistance from DCI Special Agent Nick Gates and then turn the evidence over to SA Gates once the scene processing was completed. I was also advised that Trooper Michael Smith from the Wisconsin State Patrol Technical Reconstruction Unit was in route to complete the scene mapping.

I photographed the scene while waiting for SA Gates to arrive on scene.

Detective Sielski and I examined the scene after initial scene photographs were completed. Detective Sielski and I marked the evidence located with orange plastic numbered cone placards numbered 1-20 and yellow evidence markers 1-5 (as items 21-25) due to the limited number of orange cone placard available.

Detective Sielski and I located one 9mm shell casing (marked with evidence placard 1) east of the center of 28<sup>th</sup> Ave to the east of the parked Dodge Journey's driver's door in a crack in the roadway. I located a Taser prong (placard 2) several feet west of this shell casing near the same crack in the roadway.

Moving closer to the Dodge Journey's driver's door, I saw several bloodstains on the pavement. Near the edge of the most south east blood stain, I located another Taser prong (placard 3) and the set of keys for the Dodge Journey (placard 4). Approximately 2 feet or so west of that blood stain, I saw a fired Taser cartridge and Taser wire (placards 5 & 6). It was later determined the Taser wire was still attached to the fired cartridge and was collected as 1 item.

Approximately 2-3 feet east of the left rear tire of the Journey I located a fired mushroomed bullet in the road (placard 7).

I looked under the vehicle and located a Taser probe in front of the rear axle of the Journey approximately 1 1/2-2 feet under the vehicle from the left rocker panel (placard 8). Just under the

left side of the vehicle and slightly behind the open driver's door of the vehicle I located a Motorola cell phone (placard 9) and a pack of Newport cigarettes (placard 10). The pack of cigarettes appeared to have a small amount of blood on the outside of the package.

Near the back of the left rear tire I located an "NBA Finals" baseball style hat (placard 11). I saw several cash bills on the ground near the left rear tire and in the west gutter of 28<sup>th</sup> Ave. The bills in the west gutter were later marked with placards 13 and 14 but the bills near the left rear tire were not marked with a placard. All the bills were later recovered as one item for DCI. The bills consisted of 5 \$20.00 bills and 6 \$1.00 bills for a total of \$106.00.

I located a blue KPD baseball hat in the west gutter of the road just behind the Journey (placard 12). The hat can be identified as KPD Unit 618's based on the embroidered unit number on the back of the hat.

I looked inside the Journey from the driver's door and saw a grey knife on the driver's side floor inside the vehicle (placard 15). The knife was not removed from the vehicle at the scene and was inside the vehicle when it was later towed from the scene by Jensen's Towing for evidence. DCI advised they would recover the knife once a search warrant was issued for the vehicle.

Under the left rear bumper of the Journey I located a green Taser blast door (placard 16). Additional Taser blast doors were located on the west curb just behind the vehicle (placard 17), east of the rear bumper several feet (placard 18) and in the parkway grass just west of the rear bumper of the Journey (placard 25 (yellow marker #5)).

Upon examining the hood of the vehicle a silver 9mm shell casing (placard 19) was located in the windshield wiper well on the passenger side of the front of the vehicle.

Upon searching outside the passenger side of the Journey on the grass parkway west of the vehicle, I located several additional 9mm shell casings. I located 3 shell casings in the grass in front of the front passenger door (placards 20, 21 (yellow #1), 22 (yellow #2)). I located a shell casing in the parkway grass just to the west of the front passenger door opening (placard 23 (yellow #3)). One additional shell casing was located in the west gutter adjacent to the right front tire of the Journey (placard 24 (yellow #4)). A total of seven shell casings were located during the on scene investigation.

I photographed all the marked evidentiary items in place.

Trooper Smith measured the scene and the items of evidence.

Once the scene measurements and photographs were completed, Detective Sielski, Deputy Eckert and I collected and packaged the items of evidence.

Due to a large, growing and violent crowd at the scene, a decision was made to tow the Journey from the scene for further processing at a later time. The Journey was towed by Jensen's Towing to the secure KSD tow yard at KCDC. Deputy Eckert followed Jensen's to KCDC.

Detective Sielski and responded to the PSB and met with SA Gates. I completed a log of the evidence items recovered from the scene for SA Gates and turned all evidentiary items over to SA Gates.

I took no further action at this time.
