NARRATIVE

On 09-02-20 at approximately 1:00 PM I, Detective Joshua Schreiner #268, responded to the Kenosha Police Department (1000 55th Street) administrative conference room in reference to four suspicious packages. These packages were deemed suspicious due to their appearance and the recent civil unrest in Kenosha County towards Kenosha Law Enforcement after the officer involved shooting of Jacob Blake.

I am an FBI certified Bomb Technician and have been a member of the Kenosha County Sheriff's Department Bomb Squad since 2017. In November of 2018, I received my Federal Bureau of Investigations Hazardous Devices Technician certification at the Hazardous Devices School located at Redstone Arsenal Military Base in Huntsville, AL. I have received ongoing training both locally and from the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) in the identification of explosives, identification of explosive devices and improvised explosive devices, recognition of components related to the making of explosive devices, as well as rendering safe procedures. I have also been certified by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives (BATFE) in Advanced Explosives Disposal Techniques (AEDT), Post Blast Investigation Techniques, and Homemade Explosives (HME).

Upon arrival I observed there to be four packages on the administration conference room table within the Kenosha Police Department. Members of the Kenosha County Sheriff's Department Bomb Squad took several x-rays of the packages. The packages are described as follows:
