NARRATIVE

On 08-24-20, I Deputy [REDACTED] was assigned to the Kenosha County Sheriff's Department Crowd Control Unit. I was on duty with the Crowd Control Team and we were deployed to the front of the Kenosha County Courthouse (956 56th ST).

There were angry protesters in front of the courthouse. Myself and the KSD Crowd Control Team were in a line formation standing in front of the courthouse facing south. Several angry protesters began to gather in front of the courthouse directly south of where we were in formation and they were facing the team and yelling insults at us.

This continued for numerous hours and while standing in a line formation I donned my Crowd Control gear which included: riot helmet, riot shield, knee/leg padding, gas mask, along with my everyday duty belt and body armor. All of the gear weighs approximately 40 to 45 pounds.

I used my single right hand to hold my shield slightly above waste level to shield myself due to the violent protesters, who suddenly and without warning, began to throw frozen plastic water bottles, large rocks, hammers, and explosive device at the Crowd Control Team.

The constant lifting of the shield and the movements of using the shield to protect myself and other team members, along with the prolonged standing in a line formation, and weight bearing of the duty belt along with the added weight of the Crowd Control equipment caused pain to the right side of my lower back.

Myself and the Crowd Control team were not released from our duties until approximately 0600 hours of 08/25. I did not remove myself from Crowd Control when I started experiencing pain. I remained on line until I was relieved of my duties.

During the course of the week of the civil unrest my lower back continued to cause me pain but I did not formally report the incident to the Crowd Control Chain of Command because I assumed the pain was not unusual for the amount of activity and thought of it as soreness. I believed the pain would subside after a few days of rest once my duties of Crowd Control were completed.

At this time my back continues to cause me pain and uneasiness during every day activity such as sitting and standing for prolonged periods of time. The pain is a constant throbbing and burning sensation to my right lower back and occasionally I experience sharp pains traveling up the side of my back. The pain intensifies during my duty hours due to having to sit for long periods of time while I'm operating my squad car to conduct patrols.

On 08/24/20 I was assigned to the Kenosha County Sheriff's Department Crowd Control Unit as a less-than lethal (PepperBall) operator. Beginning at approximately 1700 hours I was stationed at the main entrance of the Kenosha County Court House (south side) and was positioned on the steps leading into the court house, facing south. Our role was to keep protesters away from the court house entrance. I was in place to provide back-up and cover to those maintaining a line between the protesters and the court house and to deter those that were projecting items in our direction.

While maintaining this position protesters were projecting numerous items in our direction. This included; water bottles, rocks, tools, fireworks, etc. At approximately 2115 hours an unknown explosive device detonated next to me as I was standing guard. I immediately felt pain in my right arm and right leg. I also lost hearing in my right ear. Following this I turned around and was assisted into the court house by 2 other officers/deputies that were also on the court house steps. As of this writing I do not know their identities.

Once in the court house a medic from another department began rendering 1st aid to me. The wound/burn on my arm was the most severe. He was able bandaged and wrapped up my arm but didn't have enough supplies to also care for my leg. After taking a few minutes to collect myself I exited the court house and walked to a Nation Guard contingency that was positioned at the southwest corner of the court house. There I found another medic who was able to care for the wound to my leg. Once it was bandaged and wrapped I returned to my position on the court house steps. After approximately another hour I regained the hearing in my right ear. Both unit commanders on scene, Sergeant Funk, Keith and Sergeant Forester, Chase, were notified of this incident shortly after it occurred.

Once our assignment ended, approximately 0500 hours on 08/25/20, I completed Accident/Injury paperwork and forwarded same to Kathy Kemen. I also notified my usual immediate supervisor, Lieutenant Gilley, Tom, of this incident. Following this incident I did not seek any outside medical attention and as of this writing I do not intend to.

On 08/28/20 I was able to review security camera footage from outside the court house. Prior to detonation, the object can be seen landing on the ground next to me. It appears to have come from the west, my left side, and lands behind me. I have saved the camera footage and photos of my injuries should they be needed in the future. END OF REPORT

NARRATIVE

On 08-24-20, I [REDACTED] was assigned to the Kenosha County Sheriff's Department Crowd Control Unit as a Squad Leader. I was on duty with the Crowd Control Team and we were deployed to the front of the Kenosha County Courthouse (956 56th ST).

There were angry protesters in front of the courthouse myself and the KSD Crowd Control Team was in a line formation standing in front of the courthouse facing south. Several angry protesters began to gather in front of the courthouse directly south of where we were in formation and they were facing the team and yelling insults at us.

Then suddenly without warning, the protesters began to throw frozen plastic water bottles, large rocks, hammers, and explosive device at the Crowd Control team. At approximately 2115 hrs, an unknown explosive device detonated next to me as I was standing and exploded near my left ear. My hearing in my left ear became muffled and I heard a ringing noise in my ear.

I mentioned the incident to Dep. M. Preston #246, who was standing next to me when the incident occurred. I also discussed the incident with some members of the Crowd Control team after we were secured for the day. I did not formally report the incident to the Crowd Control Chain of Command. Sgt. B. Doe #1345 was standing next to me and was injured by the explosive device also. I did not remove myself from the Crowd Control when the incident occurred. I remained on line as squad leader.

I did not see who used the device and did not actually see the device itself.

The following morning the ringing in my ear stopped but my hearing in that ear was still muffled. I did not seek any medical attention for my ear because I believed the muffled feeling would subside after a couple of days.

I completed Accident/Injury paperwork and forwarded it up the Chain of Command. I also notified my immediate supervisor, Lieutenant D. Ruth of this incident. Currently I have not sought medical attention for my left ear and do not intend to. The muffled feeling in my ear has also subsided.

I took no further action. End of report.

NARRATIVE

SUMMARY

On 8-24-2020 [REDACTED] was injured by an explosive device while assigned to the Kenosha County Sheriff's Department Crowd Control Team. At this time there is no suspect information. See report.

REPORT

On 8-24-2020 the KSD Crowd Control Team was activated due to civil unrest in the City of Kenosha. The KSD Crowd Control Team was assigned to prevent rioters and protesters from further damaging or entering the Kenosha County Courthouse. [REDACTED], who is assigned the KSD Crowd Control Team, was tasked as being a less-than lethal operator, particularly as PepperBall gun operator.

During his assignment, [REDACTED] was positioned behind the KSD Crowd Control Team as a less-lethal operator. At some point, a protester/rioter threw some type of explosive device that detonated and caused injuries to [REDACTED]

I was able to watch a video earlier this week of the incident. The video shows something being thrown from the crowd that lands behind [REDACTED]. The device then rolls towards the back of his feet and then detonates with a large flash. I was unable to see who threw the device or any possible suspects, particularly due to the large crowd.
