FSM Immigration has been unable to print FSM passports since early December (please find attached the Diplomatic Note regarding the issue). This has resulted in some FSM citizens who planned to renew getting stuck over the holidays. As an interim solution, they have proposed the attached temporary travel document for their citizens and would like confirmation that it will be accepted at U.S. entry points. Could you please advise on whether the attached sample travel document would be accepted for entry by CBP officers in Guam and Honolulu in order to inform our response to the dip note?
