Reiman is hereby temporarily appointed Circuit Judge for the Eighth Judicial Circuit to hear, conduct and determine all matters presented to him in Union County Juvenile Delinquency Court, Union County Juvenile Dependency Court, Union County Circuit Criminal Court and Union County Mental Health Court.

## SENIOR JUDGES

When necessary for the orderly administration of the Eighth Judicial Circuit, and for the prompt dispatch of the business of the court, the Chief Judge may assign consenting senior judges to temporary service in any court of the Eighth Judicial Circuit, with the authority to hear, conduct, try, determine, and dispose of the cases and matters presented to him or her.

When a rule, statute or procedure mandates expedited judicial action on a matter and the judge assigned to the division is unavailable, the Chief Judge shall assign a judge to hear the case or cases.
