The statute allows the chief judge to keep a list of approved process servers, and as best as I can tell, if someone is on the list, then an Order wouldn't be required. If asked the staff attorneys if they knew if we had such a list for our circuit and they weren't aware of one.

Please keep me updated on the info as it will affect this foreclosure project I'm working on. That 3400 or 4300 number is WAY bigger than mine. It would mean that our "backlog" is bigger than everything filed last year – by a lot. I attached my spreadsheet showing the numbers I pulled from SRS – which are "filed" cases, not pending cases. Also, the "pending" tab is based on ICMS – but if the codes changed in January, then those may not be accurate because ICMS is pulling these numbers based on the codes.

However, that should not have affected the pre-January numbers... right? So the number of pending cases still would have skyrocketed.
