Sgt. Benitez and I stopped at both residences and checked in with the parents and brothers of the Kenosha officer.

CNN had already stopped at the parent's house at [REDACTED] at noon today. When they didn't answer the door, they went into their backyard. They were told to call us if they had any problems with reporters or anyone coming to their home uninvited.

As for the Kenosha officer, he gave his statement today and is at a unknown hotel but keeps in phone contact with his parents and brothers. There is no plan on him coming to live or stay in Waukesha.

The brother that resides at [REDACTED] is the [REDACTED] of [REDACTED]. Tonight, at around 8:00 p.m., he received a text message from a spoof number that said "hide your knives." All of the family are changing their cellphone numbers based on last nights threats and the continuation from today.

Spencer Sheskey, the other brother of the Kenosha officer, is [REDACTED] and lives [REDACTED]. WFD is aware of his situation as I contacted BC Haakenson to keep him in the loop. WFD was already aware and gave him the night off of work.

[REDACTED], the father, works at WMH and they allowed him to switch to day shift so that he will be home in the evening. The [REDACTED]. The house will be vacant

during day shift hours.

They don't know how their son's name got out or that he was involved in the OIS. They have another son that resides at [REDACTED], unknown if he is getting threatening phone calls at this time, son will be contacting us if he is also having issues. They are requesting extra checks at this time for both residences. They will call back if the situation escalates. The calls are coming into the homes landline which they will be disconnecting. Both [REDACTED] cellphones are listed below in case we need to contact them.
