FACTS TO SUPPORT ABOVE CHARGE(S):

At approx. 9:45 PM on 11/13/08, TPD received a call about a home invasion robbery, at [REDACTED]. According to the victim, [REDACTED], he was in his bedroom with [REDACTED], and another female, [REDACTED] was in the living room. The victim advised his bedroom door was closed and he heard someone walking towards the bedroom. The victim advised [REDACTED] opened the bedroom door and two unknown black males barged into his bedroom and pointed a silver handgun at him. The victim advised [REDACTED] fled the bedroom, and the suspects demanded his property. Fearing for his life/safety, the victim turned over the following items: \$113 dollars in cash, silver necklace, silver bracelet, gold men's Geneva watch with black face and clear stone at the 12 and 6 o'clock position, 4 knit hats (1 pink, 1 blue, 1 black, 1 unknown color), and his Boost Mobile cell phone (px 850-459-[REDACTED]).

The victim described the suspects as follows: suspect #1 black male approx. 5'10", 160-170 pounds, mustache, wearing a dark jacket, dark or black shorts, white shoes, and a nylon type cap with a knot on top. Suspect #2 black male approx. 5'10", 160-170, mustache, goatee, dark pants, bluish colored shirt. I also spoke Rodriguez, and she described one of the suspects as wearing a long green t-shirt, and advised one of the suspects was armed with a silver handgun.

Confidential intelligence indicated that property stolen during the home invasion robbery was in the area of the Budget Inn ([REDACTED]). Surveillance was initiated in the area of the motel and 2 black males matching the description were seen moving about the motel. The black males were wearing the same clothing described by the victim and witness. The black male in the green shirt (later found to be [REDACTED] was observed in the east parking lot of the motel and a citizen contact was conducted. Ofc. Lowery and Sgt. Gereg made contact with the subject and I noticed he was talking on cell phone at the time. I used my city issued cell phone, blocked the number, and called the victim's cell phone. As the phone started to ring, I observed [REDACTED] look down at the phone in his hand, and Sgt. Gereg confirmed the phone rang at the same time. [REDACTED] was then taken into custody. The cell phone was recovered and there was a private call at 3:22 AM, which was the call I placed to the phone. Search incident to arrest of [REDACTED] Ofc. Lowery found \$109 in US currency, a silver necklace, silver bracelet, consistent with the items stolen from the victim, in his pants pocket. [REDACTED] also had the room key for #203 in his right front pants pocket.

Once [REDACTED] was taken into custody, he advised Ofc. Lowery he needed to use the

The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe, and does believe that the above named Defendant on Thursday November 13TH 2008, at approximately 21:45, at 2616 Mission Rd #12 did the following violation of law:

Once [REDACTED] was taken into custody, he advised Ofc. Lowery he needed to use the restroom. He advised he was staying in room [REDACTED], and had the room key to this room. [REDACTED] advised no one else was staying with him and his friend had rented the room. We walked up to room [REDACTED] so that [REDACTED] could use the restroom. Inv. Baldwin knocked on the door, and heard someone inside. [REDACTED] answered the door. He matched the description of the other suspect in the home invasion (black jacket, dark shorts, cap with knot on top). [REDACTED] was patted down for officer safety and detained. After both subjects were detained, Inv. Baldwin asked for consent to search the hotel room [REDACTED] for any weapons. [REDACTED] refused to allow officers consent to search the motel room.

Inv. Boccio made contact with the office at the motel and found that room [REDACTED] is registered to [REDACTED] (address given [REDACTED]). He was also told that room [REDACTED] is registered to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] had a key to room [REDACTED] in his pocket found incident to arrest.

Inv. Boccio interviewed both subjects. Post Miranda, [REDACTED] admitted to being present at the time of the robbery in the victim's apartment. [REDACTED] then went on to say all parties involved went back to his motel room [REDACTED] after the robbery. [REDACTED] admitted to receiving a cell phone for payment for his involvement in this incident. [REDACTED] then goes on to say he heard the girl involved in this case asked the
