**Subject:** Restricting scope of Public Records Request from ACLU

Dear Barbara,

This email memorializes the discussion we had on today's call with Tony Peluso regarding further restricting the scope of the public records request from the ACLU dated March 13, 2014.

The ACLU is dropping categories 2, 5, and 6 of the request. Accordingly, there is no need to search for information responsive to those categories.

As to category 1, if your discussions with the comptroller's office result in the conclusion that there are not likely to be responsive records, then the ACLU would be open to dropping that category as well.

The ACLU still seeks records responsive to categories 3 and 4 of the request.

For categories 7, 8, 9, and 10, the ACLU would like to limit the search to records from the 2010 calendar year. After you are able to estimate the processing time for this more limited search, the ACLU will determine whether it will be able to pay the full estimated cost, or whether we would like to further restrict the search.
