Documents (Dkt. #), the papers submitted by the parties in support of and in opposition to the		
motion, the files and pleadings in this case, and being fully advised in the premises, now,		
therefore, it is hereby		
ORDERED that Defendants' Motion to Compel is GRANTED. For every document th		
Defendants assert the law enforcement privilege, Defendants must provide Plaintiffs with an		
affidavit or declaration from the head of the department (1) affirming that the agency generated		
or collected the materials at issue and maintained its confidentiality; (2) stating that the official		
has personally reviewed the materials in question; (3) identifying specific government interests		
that would be threatened by disclosure to plaintiff and/or plaintiffs' counsel; and (4) describing		
how disclosure subject to the parties' Stipulated Protective Order would create a substantial risk		
of harm to government interests. Within 21 days from the issuance of this order, Defendants		
shall either produce such affidavits or declarations for any documents to which Defendants have		
already asserted the law enforcement privilege, or produce unredacted versions of the		
documents.		
It is further ORDERED that within 21 days of this order, Defendants must produce		
revised privilege logs that clearly identify the agency official who has personally reviewed the		
material and invoked the privilege, and which explain in detail how disclosure of the requested		
information, subject to the Stipulated Protective Order, would implicate a specific law		
enforcement interest.
