At the request of Your Honor's chambers, we write to provide the Court with the status of appellate proceedings in the above-referenced Freedom of Information Act cases.

ACLU v. Department of Justice, 12 Civ. 794 (CM): Following entry of judgment on July 23, 2015 (ECF No. 132), the parties filed notices of appeal (ECF Nos. 134-135). Those appeals were docketed as Second Circuit Dkt. Nos. 15-2956(L) and 15-3122 (XAP). On August 30, 2016, after the appeals had been fully briefed, the Second Circuit issued the enclosed mandate remanding the appeals for the limited purpose of clarifying certain aspects of this Court's Order filed on July 16, 2015, a copy of which is also enclosed. The Second Circuit has scheduled oral argument on the appeals for October 25, 2016, at 2:30 p.m.

<u>ACLU v. Department of Justice</u>, 15 Civ. 1954 (CM): Following this Court's Memorandum Decision and Order filed on August 8, 2016 (ECF No. 83), the Court entered a Joint Stipulation and Order on September 13, 2016 (ECF No. 93), dismissing plaintiffs' remaining claims with prejudice. Judgment has not yet been entered, and no notices of appeal have been filed by either party.
