In July 2017, DHS held an industry day to pursue a contract to automate the current manual process of screening applicants for entry to the United States and immigration benefits as well as the process of creating deportation leads. In February 2018, DHS announced that it is moving forward with this contract following a closed procurement process. The contractor would be responsible for "exploit[ing]" information from sources such as social media websites, blogs, conferences, and academic websites. The contractor would be required to use automated processes to generate 10,000 investigative leads annually, to evaluate applicants' "probability of becoming a positively contributing member of society as well as their ability to contribute to the national interests," and to "assess whether an applicant intends to commit criminal or terrorist acts after entering the United States."5
