This action transfers \$1.3 million from the Military Personnel, Army, 07/07, appropriation to Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities, Defense, 07/07, appropriation. This action reprograms funds in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which funds were originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest.
