SPECIFICALLY, REQUEST SERE PSYCHOLOGISTS COMMENT ON THE SHORT AND LONG TERM PSYCHOLOGICAL EFFECTS OF THE WATER BOARD AND MOCK BURIAL AND, IF AVAILABLE, STATISTICS ON WHAT LONG TERM MENTAL HEALTH ISSUES RESULTED FROM USING THESE TECHNIQUES IN THE SERE TRAINING. PLEASE KEEP IN MIND THE STATUTORY DEFINITION THAT THE TECHNIQUE MUST NOT CAUSE SEVERE MENTAL PAIN OR SUFFERING. WE UNDERSTAND, FROM OUR CONVERSATIONS

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WITH JPRA, THE WATER BOARD AND MOCK BURIAL ARE NO LONGER BEING USED BECAUSE THEY ARE EXTREMELY EFFECTIVE, PREVENTING THE STUDENT FROM LEARNING THE FUNDAMENTALS OF RESISTANCE IN A MEASURED WAY. WE ARE ALSO RESEARCHING THIS SUBJECT.
