We understand that Elias Mohamed, one of our seven clients no longer on the No Fly List as of last October, recently received an email notification from the U.S. consulate in Jeddah. That notification requested that Mr. Mohamed schedule a time late next week for a meeting at the consulate to "update" him on his "travel status." Mr. Mohamed does not know how the consulate obtained his email address, as he does not recall ever corresponding with or providing his contact information to anyone there.

We would appreciate an explanation as to why he was contacted in this manner and what specifically is to be conveyed in this "update." We also emphasize that any communications with our clients that relate to the matters at issue in this lawsuit must be directed to counsel.
