Pursuant to Fed. R. App. P. 28(j), Plaintiffs—Appellants American Civil Liberties Union and American Civil Liberties Union Foundation (together, "ACLU") hereby call to the Court's attention the following exchange between Director of National Intelligence James R. Clapper and Senator Bill Nelson at a February 11, 2014 hearing of the Senate Armed Services Committee, during which Mr. Clapper acknowledged the Central Intelligence Agency's "use of drones."

Sen. Nelson: It is—you tell me if this is correct—
the administration's policy that they
are exploring shifting the use of
drones, unmanned aerial vehicle
strikes, from the CIA to the DOD. Is
that an accurate statement?

Mr. Clapper: Yes, sir, it is. . . .
