MOTION TO DISMISS PURSUANT TO FRCP 12

AND NOW, comes the Defendant, Mary Jo Poknis, in her official capacity as

Register of Wills of Washington County (hereinafter, "this Defendant" or "Ms. Poknis") by and through her attorney, Robert J. Grimm, Esquire, and Swartz Campbell, LLC to move this Court to dismiss certain Plaintiffs and claims pursuant to the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. This Defendant respectfully requests the following:

- 1. This Court should dismiss Plaintiffs' claims against Ms. Poknis pursuant to Fed.R.C.P. 12(b)(1) because they lack standing to sue her.
- 2. This Court should dismiss Plaintiffs' claims against Ms. Poknis pursuant to Fed.R.C.P. 12(b)(3) or in the alternative, transfer venue to the Western District of Pennsylvania because venue is most proper in the Western District of Pennsylvania.
- 3. This Court should dismiss Plaintiffs' claims against Ms. Poknis on the basis of lack of subject matter jurisdiction pursuant to Fed.R.C.P. 12 (b)(7) because of the Plaintiffs' failure to name indispensable parties in their Complaint.
- 4. This Court should dismiss Plaintiffs' claims against Ms. Poknis pursuant to Fed.R.C.P. 12(b)(6) on the grounds that she is entitled to absolute and/or qualified immunity.
- 5. Ms. Poknis is also shielded with immunity from the injunctive relief requested by Plaintiffs, so this Court should rule accordingly and dismiss those claims.

6. Finally, the Court should strike the Plaintiffs' claims for attorneys' fees as

Ms. Poknis is immune from the claims for attorneys' fees and should not be
bear this ominous burden for following the law.

7. In support of this Motion, this Defendant relies on its brief, which will be filed in accordance with the Stipulation approved by this Court on Septmeber 13, 2013.

8. Pursuant to LR 7.1, this Defendant's counsel sought concurrence in this Motion from all parties, and it was denied by Plaintiffs. Defendant Petrille concurs in this Motion. Defendant Kane takes no position on this Motion. Defendants Corbett and Wolf concur in the substantive Motion of Ms. Poknis, but do not concur in the venue request.
