ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Petitioner Patrick W. Ferguson has filed a Motion Under 28 U.S.C. § 2255 to Vacate or Set Aside Conviction and Incorporated Memorandum of Law (DE# 1, 7/12/19) (hereinafter "Motion"). Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636 and the Magistrate Rules of the Local Rules of the Southern District of Florida, this matter was referred to the undersigned by the Honorable Ursula Ungaro (DE# 4, 7/15/19). Accordingly, it is ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. To prevent motions for extension of time, counsel for the Respondent is notified that an extended period for the response has been provided in this case. No motions for extension of time will be granted except upon good cause shown.

2. Within ten (10) days of receipt of this Order, counsel for the Respondent shall file the name of the lawyer or lawyers to whom the case is assigned.

3. On or before forty-five (45) days from the date of this Order, Respondent shall file a memorandum of fact and law to show cause why the Motion should not be granted, accompanied by all supporting documentation.

4. The Petitioner shall have an opportunity to file a reply within fourteen (14) days of receipt of the response.

5. The parties shall submit proposed orders prepared for the signature of the United States District or Magistrate Judge, to accompany all appropriate motions sent to the Court until the final disposition of the case, in compliance with Southern District of Florida Local Rule 7.1 A(2). Additionally, the parties are to submit the proposed orders to the Judge via e-mail in accordance with the CM/ECF Administrative Procedures.
