**NOTICE OF LODGING**

The government hereby notifies the Court and the plaintiffs that, in compliance with orders from two judges of this Court, the Department of Justice transferred custody of the full Senate Select Committee on Intelligence Committee Study of the CIA’s Detention and Interrogation Program (“SSCI Report”) in its possession to the Court Information Security Officers serving the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia. *See* Notice, attached, and Orders of December 28, 2016 (Civil Action 08-1207) and January 23, 2017 (Civil Action No. 08-1360, ordering the SSCI Report to be preserved and a copy deposited with the Court Security Officer by February 10, 2017).

With respect to this case, the Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit ruled on May 15, 2015, that the SSCI report was not an agency record subject to FOIA. Plaintiffs filed a petition for certiorari to the Supreme Court, and the government’s opposition to the petition is due on March 15, 2017.
