## AGREED ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This Order dismisses all claims made in the above-captioned case by Leaders of a Beautiful Struggle, Erricka Bridgeford, and Kevin James ("Plaintiffs"), against the Baltimore Police Department and Baltimore Police Commissioner Michael S. Harrison in his official capacity ("Defendants").

The Plaintiffs and Defendants (collectively, "the parties") agree that this case has been settled, and that all issues and controversies, as described in the Settlement Agreement, have been resolved to their mutual satisfaction. The parties request the Court to retain jurisdiction to enforce the terms of the Settlement Agreement under the authority of *Kokkonen v. Guardian Life Insurance Co. of America*, 511 U.S. 375, 381–82 (1994).

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. The parties entered into the Settlement Agreement on January 5, 2022, a copy of which is attached to and made a part of this Order.
- 2. The parties shall comply with the terms of the Settlement Agreement entered into on January 5, 2022. The parties expressly waive their rights under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure

65(d) to the extent Rule 65(d) requires this order to be specific in terms or to describe in reasonable detail and without reference to the settlement agreement the act or acts to be restrained.

3. By consent of the parties, the Court shall retain jurisdiction for the purpose of enforcing the terms of the Settlement Agreement, as set forth in the Settlement Agreement.

4.	Except as provid	led for in paragrap	phs 1-3 above, this case is dismissed,	with prejudice.
