


Dkt. No. 76-2. The *Vaughn* index provided information about certain information withheld, pursuant to FOIA exemptions, from 46 documents that Plaintiffs indicated they intended to challenge in this litigation. The *Vaughn* index did not contain certain other information that had been previously provided to Plaintiffs for the purpose of potentially narrowing the scope of Plaintiffs' challenges in this case, including information about attachments to the challenged documents, and information about other documents that Plaintiffs have indicated they are challenging only as to the adequacy of the agency's search, not the agency's withholding of information pursuant to FOIA exemptions.

4. At Plaintiffs' request, attached hereto is a revised *Vaughn* index identical in all respects to the index attached as Exhibit B to the previously-filed DoD Declaration, except that it reflects information about attachments to the challenged DoD documents, and also includes information about CENTCOM/019, which is one of the documents that Plaintiffs have indicated they are challenging only with respect to the adequacy of the agency's search, not the agency's withholding of information pursuant to FOIA exemptions.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
