4. Plaintiff Asad Dandia waives any and all allegations and claims that he has suffered

economic harm resulting from surveillance or investigations by the New York City Police

Department.

5. Plaintiff Mohammad Elshinawy waives any and all allegations and claims that he has

suffered economic harm resulting from surveillance or investigations by the New York City

Police Department.

6. Nothing in these stipulations precludes any individual Plaintiff from providing evidence

related to an institutional Plaintiff.
