DECLARATION OF SCOTT L. SEGGERMAN

- 1. I am currently a Program Manager for Data Assets at the Defense Manpower Data Center ("DMDC"). In this capacity, I am responsible for providing data to both internal and external customers to the Department of Defense ("DoD") to answer inquiries about Military and Civilian Personnel. In this capacity, I have access to many databases at DMDC representing various populations of both sponsors and dependents affiliated with DoD. I make this declaration based upon my personal knowledge, observation, and investigation of the matters set forth herein, as well as on information available to me in the course of my official duties.
- 2. On October 14, 2021, consistent with my duties and responsibilities, I was tasked to run a query of the Defense Manpower Data Center's Person Data Repository. Specifically, I was asked to identify the number of noncitizen Active Duty Service members who began service between March 1, 2021 and August 31, 2021. Further, I was asked to identify the number of noncitizen National Guard and Reserve Component Service members who began service between September 1, 2020 through August 31, 2021.

3. I ran the query as instructed and my results were as follows:
