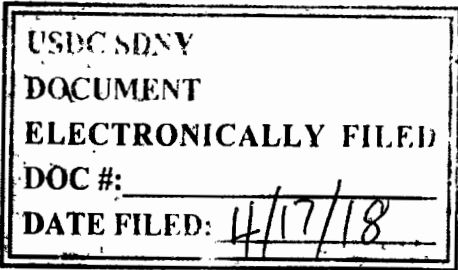

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**ORDER ON REDACTED  
TRANSCRIPT**

ALVIN K. HELLERSTEIN, U.S.D.J.:

On March 27, 2018, I issued an “Order and Notice on Redacted Transcript,” denying certain redactions proposed by the government of the transcript of the *in camera* hearing held before me on January 18, 2018. In a letter dated April 10, 2018, the government objected to certain of my rulings (*see* Notice of Lodging of Classified Submission, Dkt. No. 91). The following are my rulings on the government’s objections:


- **Page 5:** The objections are overruled.
- **Page 6:** The objections are sustained, except with respect to line 20 and the first word of line 21, which may not be redacted.
- **Page 12:** The objections are overruled. Page 12 shall contain no redactions except for the proposed redactions on line 2.

- **Page 13:** The objections are overruled, except with respect to lines 11–12, which may be redacted.
- **Page 14:** The objections are overruled.
- **Page 17:** The objections are overruled.
- **Page 21:** The objection is sustained.

Within 10 days, the Government shall prepare and docket a transcript consistent with my order dated March 27, 2018, as modified herein.
