ORDER

The Court has reviewed the plaintiffs' "Motion for Order Requiring Disclosure or Information Regarding COVID-19 Vaccines for Class Members" at BCBIC. ECF 721 (the "Motion"). Defendants are directed to respond to the Motion by the close of business on May 21, 2021.

Defendants are also directed to file a status report by the same date, apprising the Court as to the status of the COVID-19 outbreak and vaccine distribution efforts at BCBIC. Defendants should include data showing in total how many people incarcerated in the jail as of May 20, 2021, have been offered the vaccine, and how many have actually been vaccinated. In addition, defendants should include data for each housing unit of BCBIC, reflecting the number of inmates and the number who have been vaccinated.
