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The Board is a representative body elected by the registered voters of the District to provide for and oversee the operation of the public schools as mandated by state law. The Board is, accordingly, accountable to the electorate and will be responsive to the educational needs of the District and the imposed financial constraints.

In carrying out this function, the Board recognizes the following general responsibilities as paramount:

1. Formulating and interpreting policies to govern the operation of the District within the constraints of state and federal statutes and regulations.
2. Delegating administrative duties to the Superintendent and other designated school officials.
3. Administering District funds judiciously and making decisions concerning educational and budgetary matters.
4. Conducting a continuous appraisal of the efficiency of the school operations, the administrative processes, and the evaluation of the educational programs of the District.
5. Performing any other functions that have been delegated to a seven-director Board by the General Assembly.

The Board will make its members, the District staff and the public aware that only the Board acting as a whole has authority to take official action.
