DIRECTOR

Based on issues that were encountered during the C/O Crooke 02 JUL 18 Use of Force investigation, the following items must be addressed. Both Chief Fredericks and Warden David should be disciplined for not acting in a timely manner regarding bringing charges against CO Crooke for violation of BOC policies and procedures, as both were negligent in the performance of their duties. Based on the information on hand within hours of this event, there was no need for an Administrative Investigation (based upon Administrative Investigation Policy Section C. General Responsibilities Sub-Section 3, paragraph a. An Administrative Investigation need not be conducted when sufficient facts are known, admitted to or otherwise not in dispute based upon the information contained in the Administrative Inquiry Memorandum).

As stated on page six (6) of the C/O Crooke 02 JUL 18 Use of Force investigation:

As required by BOC Policy:

- a. An Incident Report and a Use of Force report are to be completed by all staff directly involved in an incident.
 - i. C/O Potter failed to complete and submit an Incident Report to the shift supervisor.
- b. Staff shall submit the Incident Report to the Shift Supervisor.
 - i. C/O Potter failed to complete and submit an Incident Report to the shift supervisor.
 - ii. The shift supervisor Chief Fredericks failed to collect an Incident report from C/O Potter.
- c. Staff must complete the Incident Report prior to the end of their shift and departing the facility.
 - i. C/O Potter failed to complete the Incident Report prior to departing the facility.
- d. The Use of Force Incident Report submitted by CO Crooke has an incorrect date in the narrative.
 - i. That neither the Shift Supervisor Chief Fredericks nor the Warden David caught or corrected or required additional clarification.
- e. CO Crooke completed the Use of Force report on Monday, 02 JUL 18.
 - i. Chief Fredericks failed to properly complete the Shift Supervisor signature line on page 8 of Section I Supervisors/Managers Review of Use of Force Incident Report, and does not have a Date/Time, Approval: Yes/No, Present at the Scene, Clarifications Needed, all of which were left blank.
 - ii. Chief Fredericks failed to complete the Supervisor's Supplement (Pages 9 and 10) on the Use of Force Incident Report Form
- f. Warden DAVID Approved – Yes and with no need for clarification on 7/5/18.

- i. Warden David failed to have the omission(s) rectified.
 - g. Referral for Administrative Investigation by Warden – Yes -- date left blank.
 - i. This report was approved by Warden David without a recommendation for referral for an Administrative Investigation.
 - ii. Warden David had access to the Use of Force Report, wherein CO Crooke reported that he placed the inmate in a “neck hold”.
 - h. The Incident Commander’s Review/Critique should have been completed within 48 hours of the incident.
 - i. Chief Fredericks Incident Commander’s Review/Critique was completed on 10 AUG 18, 39 days after the incident occurred.
 - ii. See the highlighted sections of the attached form.
 - iii. Chief Frederick assessment is off base, regarding de-escalation, cooling off period, type and manner of the force used, and medical attention required. With the aid of the video recording this Use of Force incident was clearly outside of Policy, procedure and training.
- 2. Court Transcripts
 - a. Warden David testified that he observed (Video review) the officer (CO Crooke) approached him in an aggressive manner . . .
 - i. Warden David had enough information after reviewing the video to charge CO Crooke.
 - b. Warden David stated that “The Officer approached Mr. Hodge and Mr. Hodge was retreating.”
 - i. Warden David had enough information after reviewing the video to charge CO Crooke
 - c. ... I didn’t observe the chokehold.
 - i. The choke hold can be seen on cameras 8 and 9 between 15:54:55 and 15:55:3.

SYNOPSIS: Inmate Benjamin Hodge filed a grievance stating that Correction Officer Jamal Crooke assaulted him.

CORRECTIONS OFFICER MALIK HODGE INCIDENT REPORTS REVIEW

C/O HODGE reported that he was assigned to security on 02 JUL 18 during the 08-16 Shift, while he was in Central Control he observed C/O Crooke on camera 8, Cluster 6, making hand gestures. As he was responding to Cluster 6 he passed C/O Crook in the hallway. When C/O HODGE arrived at Cluster 6 along with C/Os Mendali LETTSOME and Merwin POTTER, he heard screaming coming from Cell 2. All the Inmates in the dayroom were secured in their respective cells. C/O HODGE reported that C/O Crooke and Chief Myron FREDRICKS entered Cluster 6 while he was still there and that Acting Shift Supervisor Jalani CHARLESWELL was advised of the situation.

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CORRECTION OFFICER M. HODGE INTERVIEW OVERVIEW

C/O Hodge stated that saw C/O Crooke on Camera 8 and responded to Cluster 6. On the way to Cluster 6 he passed C/O Crooke in the hallway and when he arrived at Cluster 6 with C/O M LETTSOME, C/O M POTTER and the inmates were in the dayroom and he assisted in securing the inmates in their cells. C/O Crooke and Chief FREDRICKS entered the unit and he left and advised Acting Shift Supervisor of the situation.

CORRECTIONS OFFICER MENDALI LETTSOME INCIDENT REPORTS REVIEW

C/O LETTSOME reported that she was in Cluster 3 & 4 control booth when the Cluster 4 Inmates began banging on the glass and pointing toward Cluster 5 & 6. C/O LETTSOME enter Cluster 6 and saw C/O Crooke standing in the dayroom and heard an Inmate (B. HODGE) who was secured in his cell arguing. C/O LETTSOME instructed the Inmate to go to their respective cells and all inmates were secured.

CORRECTION OFFICER M. LETTSOME INTERVIEW OVERVIEW

C/O LETTSOME stated that the inmates in Cluster 4 made her aware of something going on in Cluster 6 and that she responded to Cluster 6 and instructed the inmates to go to their cell where they secured. Inmate B. HODGE was in his cell when she arrived at Cluster 6.

CORRECTIONS OFFICER JAMAL CROOKE USE OF FORCE REPORT REPORTS REVIEW

C/O J CROOKE reported that Inmate B. HODGE notified him that there was bug on his chicken patty and told Inmate B. HODGE that he would change out his food. C/O J CROOKE took the food to the kitchen and notified Cook Maria CALLWOOD who said it wasn't a bug and she went to the Warden's office and returned saying that even David agreed that it ain't no bug. The tray was replaced by Cook and C/O J CROOKE went back to Cluster 6 and gave the tray to Inmate B. HODGE. C/O J CROOKE told Inmate B. HODGE that it wasn't a bug and Inmate B. HODGE replied "Fuck you, I ain't eating no fucking bug, fuck wah you think". C/O J CROOKE instructed Inmate B. HODGE to watch how you talk to him, please, and Inmate B. HODGE responded "Fuck you yuh clown".

C/O J CROOKE reported that he left Cluster 6 and returned with some water for another inmate. C/O J CROOKE report that when he returned to the unit he ordered Inmate B. HODGE to his cell and Inmate B. HODGE refused and stood up in a belligerent manner. C/O J CROOKE reported that he handed the water to the Inmate LETANG and approached Inmate B. HODGE to escort him to his cell. C/O J CROOKE reported that as he was escorting Inmate B. HODGE to his cell Inmate B. HODGE pushed C/O J CROOKE in the chest ducked down low to grab C/O J CROOKE around the waist. C/O J CROOKE reported that he grabbed Inmate B. HODGE in a neck hold to stop him Inmate B. HODGE from picking him up.

C/O J CROOKE reported that while he was holding Inmate B. HODGE he told the other Inmates to go to their cells. Inmate Cynari Fredericks open the door to cell number 2 and C/O J CROOKE placed Inmate B. HODGE in the cell and secured it. C/O J CROOKE reported that C/O M LETTSOME came into the Cluster and secured the inmates in their cells.

C/O J CROOKE reported that Chief FREDERICKS and Acting Supervisor C/O J CHARLESWELL were immediately notified.

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CORRECTION OFFICER J. CROOKE INTERVIEW OVERVIEW

C/O J CROOKE stated that Inmate B. HODGE told him that there was bug on his food and that he exchanged the tray of for a new one and told Inmate B. HODGE that the cook and the Warden said it wasn't a bug. Upon hearing this INMATE B. HODGE cussed at C/O J CROOKE and word were exchanged.

C/O J CROOKE stated he left the Cluster and came back with some water for another Inmate and that he ordered Inmate B. HODGE to go to his cell. C/O J CROOKE stated that the Inmate stood up, but did not move toward his cell. C/O J CROOKE stated that when he went to escort Inmate B. HODGE to his cell Inmate B. HODGE pushed him in the chest and then dropped down low and grabbed his pants legs in an attempt to lift him up off his feet. C/O J CROOKE stated that he put Inmate B. HODGE in a neck hold to keep from being lifted up and that he was able to walk Inmate B. HODGE to his cell and secure him.

C/O J CROOKE stated that he never had a problem with INMATE B. HODGE before this incident. C/O J CROOKE stated that INMATE B. HODGE had been fired from his Kitchen job earlier that day.

INMATE BENJAMIN HODGE INTERNAL OFFENDER'S GRIEVANCE FORM REVIEW

Investigator's note: Inmate B. HODGE prepared an Internal Inmate/Detainee Grievance Form on 05 JUL 18 stating that he was assault by C/O Crooke and that he wanted the handled in the correct and proper manner.

INMATE BENJAMIN HODGE INTERVIEW OVERVIEW

Inmate B. HODGE stated when dinner arrive the inmates are called by name to get their plates. He opened his plate and saw a roach cooked on the top of his chicken patty. Inmate B. HODGE told C/O J CROOKE and C/O J CROOKE told him to stop lying. Inmate B. HODGE showed that patty to other Inmates and then gave the plate of food back to C/O J CROOKE.

C/O J CROOKE took the plate back to the kitchen and retuned with another plate. Inmate B. HODGE stated the C/O J CROOKE told him that the Warden and the Cook said there was nothing there, Inmate B. HODGE told C/O J CROOKE that he saw what he saw and I don't want to hear it. Inmate B. HODGE stated that C/O J CROOKE approached where he was seated and told him "you think you a bad man" Inmate B. HODGE stated that he got up from the table and took his food to another table and that C/O J CROOKE followed him. Inmate B. HODGE stated he told C/O J CROOKE that "I don't want no conflict with you".

Inmate B. HODGE stated that he took the rest of his food to his cell and returned to the dayroom where he was seated. Inmate B. HODGE stated that he got up from the table and went to stand by the wall when C/O J CROOKE came back into the unit with two cups of water for another inmate. Inmate B. HODGE stated that as C/O J CROOKE was handing the cups to the other inmate and said "why you running" just before C/O J CROOKE rushed him and began throwing punches and C/O J CROOKE said "come, come" before putting him in the flush.

Inmate B. HODGE stated that he was in no way aggressive or threatening toward C/O J CROOKE. Inmate B. HODGE stated that when Chief Frederick came to the unit he told Chief Fredericks what happened and that he wanted to press charges and that Chief Frederick walk out without saying a word. Inmate B. HODGE stated that he requested a supervisor but that nobody

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came to see him and that he was not seen by medical.

Investigator's note: INMATE B. HODGE wrote a two (2) page letter dated 02 JUL 18 detailing what occurred on 02 JUL 18 between 3:30 – 4:00 PM (1530 – 1600 HRS), but based on a sentence on the second page the letter could not have been written on that date, because it references that after a week and a half he still hasn't received medical attention.

Inmate B. HODGE wrote in his letter that, when dinner was served he noticed an insect on his food and told C/O J CROOKE to change it for him. C/O J CROOKE changed the plate of food for him and commented that the Cook and the Warden said it wasn't a bug. Inmate B. HODGE and C/O J CROOKE discussed the matter and INMATE B. HODGE got up from where he seated and moved to another table and told C/O J CROOKE that he didn't want no problems with him. Inmate B. HODGE reported that C/O J CROOKE left the unit and when C/O J CROOKE return C/O J CROOKE asked "what happened" and rushed at him, throwing punches until Inmate B. HODGE was put in "flush" (chokehold). Inmate B. HODGE reported that he was held in the flush for three (3) minutes before he was put in his cell.

Inmate B. HODGE wrote that Chief Fredericks came to the unit and that he (Inmate B. HODGE) stated that he wanted to press charges but that Chief Frederick left without saying a work. INMATE B. HODGE requested to another supervisor, Monsanto, but he never came.

Inmate B. HODGE wrote that he was never given a warning or order to go to his cell by C/O J CROOKE and that he was not aggressive to C/O J CROOKE.

Inmate B. HODGE wrote that he did not receive medical attention after the incident and that his neck has been hurting.

INMATE CYMARI FREDERICKS INTERVIEW OVERVIEW

Inmate Fredericks stated that Inmate B. HODGE stood up and C/O J CROOKE asked what he was standing up for and that C/O J CROOKE attacked Inmate B. HODGE for no reason.

Inmate Fredericks stated the Chief FREDERICK came to the unit and locked everybody down for about 5 – 10 minutes and that Inmate B. HODGE was locked down for the night.

INMATE ADANEY BROWNE INTERVIEW OVERVIEW

Inmate A BROWNE stated that because of the roach on the food there was some verbal sparring. Inmate BROWNE stated the Inmate B. HODGE was not aggressive or presenting a combative posture before C/O J CROOKE rushed Inmate B. HODGE and started throwing punches and placing him in a hold.

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Investigator's Note:

1. C/O Crooke was working a double shift (16 Hours) 00-08 and 08-16 and this incident occurred in the last 15 minutes of a 16 hour tour.
2. The Use Force Report started by C/O J CROOKE has an incorrect date in the narrative JULY 7, 2018. The date of incident and C/O Crooke's signature are dated 7-2-18
3. Chief FREDERICKS signature line on page 8 of the Section I. Supervisors/Managers Review of Use of Force Incident Report, does not have a Date/Time, Approved Yes/No unmarked, Present at Scene, Clarification Needed are left blank
4. The Supervisor's Supplement (pages 9 and 10) on the Use of Force Report Form was not started, and is completely void of any information.
5. There is an attachment to the UOF report titled Benjamin Hodge's Statement Relative to Incident in Cluster 6 on 7/2/2018 which reiterates what was reported on the Inmate/Detainee Grievance Form, Inmate B. HODGE letter dated 7/2/18 and the interview conducted on 28 AUG 18, but it is unknown who prepared said document and it is unsigned.
6. Warden DAVID Approved – Yes and with no need for clarification on 7/5/18.
7. Referral for Administrative Investigation by Warden - Yes date left blank.
8. C/O M Potter did not do an Incident Report.
9. Chief Fredericks Incident Commander's Review/Critique was completed on 10 AUG 18, 39 days after the incident occurred.
10. C/O Crooke left Cluster 6 and went to the supervisor's office without being properly relieved.
11. All incidents should be reported immediately to a supervisor by radio or telephone.
12. C/O M Lettsome left Clusters 3 & 4 without being properly relieved.
13. C/O Potter was assigned to Security.
14. Was a preliminary investigation done by the Chief Fredericks based on what Inmate B HODGE said when Chief Fredericks was in the Cluster 6.
15. Chief Fredericks did not do an Incident Report.
16. Who looked at the video to see what happened prior to the referral.
17. There were three inmates who were present during the incident but were not available to be interviewed because they had been released.
18. Inmate A Browne stated that he was in his cell when the incident took place.
19. Inmates in Cluster 6 wearing street clothes.
20. Use of Force Incident occurred on 02 JUL and the Inmate was not seen by Medical until 04 JUL.
21. The Central Control logbook does not indicate that there was an Incident in Cluster 6.
22. The Cluster 6 logbook makes a minor mention that the unit was secured.
23. Unable to locate the Cluster 3 & 4 logbook.
24. This incident was not referred in a timely manner. Based upon the new Administrative Investigations and Staff Discipline Policy – BOC SEC 1006 this should not happen in the future.

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INVESTIGATIVE FINDINGS:


Based upon the interview of Inmate Benjamin Hodge, who filed a grievance alleging that force was used unnecessarily or was excessive, and statements from two other inmates who were present during the incident, and the video recording of the incident. I find that C/O J Crooke used excessive and unnecessary force against Inmate B. Hodge. In that Inmate B. Hodge was not posing threat, to C/O J CROOKE. Inmate B. HODGE was standing approximately three (3) feet away from C/O J CROOKE with his hand hanging naturally unclenched below his waist when C/O J CROOKE ran towards him and threw several punches before putting Inmate B. HODGE in a choke hold. The force used appears to have been to used in a punitive or abusive manner, it also deviated from the Use of Force Policy and or training

If an order was given by C/O J Crooke directing Inmate B. Hodge to go to his cell, as stated in C/O Crooke's Use of Force Report, Inmate Hodge was not given enough time to comply, additionally, C/O J CROOKE made no attempt to de-escalation the situation. The defensive tactic (Choke Hold) used by C/O Crooke is not authorized. Retraining on the Use of Force Policies and authorized offensive and defensive tactic is required.

Additionally, there are inconsistencies in the reporting of the amount/kind of force used with the amount/kind that was actually used and the circumstances surrounding the initiation of incident.

Inmate Benjamin Hodges

On July 2, 2018 at 3:30 - 4:00 pm, we was served Dinner. I observed an insect on my chicken pattie and told C/O Crooke to changed it for me. He said that it was not a bug and everyone looks and agreed that it was a roach. He then took the plate to the kitchen where he said the cook's and the Warden looked it over and stated that it was no insect. He brought me the next plate and was telling me what the cook's and warden said. I told him I know what I saw and I don't want to hear it. I then moved to the other side of the Unit away from him, telling him I don't want no trouble with him. He said I believe that I'm a bad man and left, huffing and puffing. At that time I was mad so I went to put my food in my room for later and came back out to sit and relax. He came back in with cops in his hands to give the man next to me and I stood up to walk off when he ask me what happen and Rushed me swinging punch. I tried my best to get away but he kept coming until he put me in a flush. I was in a flush for atleast 3 minutes fighting to breathe. He was saying stuff but I couldn't really understand while under so much pressure. He then tell me go in my cell while I'm still in the flush. Finally he pushed me in and slammed the gate. I told him that I'm pressing charges and that the camera saw everything. Chief Fredericks came and I told him I want to press charges but he walked out without saying anything. I called for the supervisor Monsanto but he said good luck and never came. I was 10 in my cell the rest of the night and I was assaulted. The camera see everything and I want to push this to the fullest extent. I te

that they are trying to cover this whole thing up due to the fact of no kind of help or support that I am not getting from anyone. The chief walked out without resolving the situation and I can not gain any contact to the warden and social worker as much as I ask for them to see me. I was given no warning or order to get to my cell by officer Creeke nor was I in anyway possible aggressive in any manner towards him. My neck has been hurting me after I was in the flush but when I ask the nurse for a pain killer, I was told to fill out a sick call. I wrote a sick call for other medical reasons and after a week and a half I still hasn't recieved medical Attention. My neck still hurts and still no medical attention, nor no warden or social worker either. I ain't done nothing wrong and the camera's would prove my statement Accurate. I don't feel comfort or safe anymore and I have my reasons. So like I said before, July 2, 2018 at Dinner time; 3:30 pm to 4:00 pm, I was assaulted for no apparent reason and would like to press charges ASAP. Thank you and I hope I can get through to someone who will do their Job.

Examples include, but are not limited to, verbal non-compliance without physical resistance or aggression, dead-weight resistance, failure to return to or come out of the cell, and linking arms.
- **Active Resistance-** A prisoner's use of physically evasive movements intended to prevent security staff from placing the prisoner in custody, including, but not limited to walking or running away, breaking an officer's grip, and pushing or pulling to prevent security staff from gaining control over the prisoner. Verbal statements, bracing or tensing alone is not active resistance.
- **Aggressive resistance-** a threat or overt act of an assault (though physical or verbal means), coupled with the present ability to carryout the threat or assault, which reasonably indicates an assault or injury to any person is likely to occur. Examples include the imminent threat of, and the act of punching, striking, kicking, biting, throwing objects capable of causing injury and head butting.
- **Deadly Resistance-** prisoner's actions that are likely to cause death, significant bodily harm to the officer or another person, or to prevent the escape of a highly dangerous or maximum sentenced prisoner.

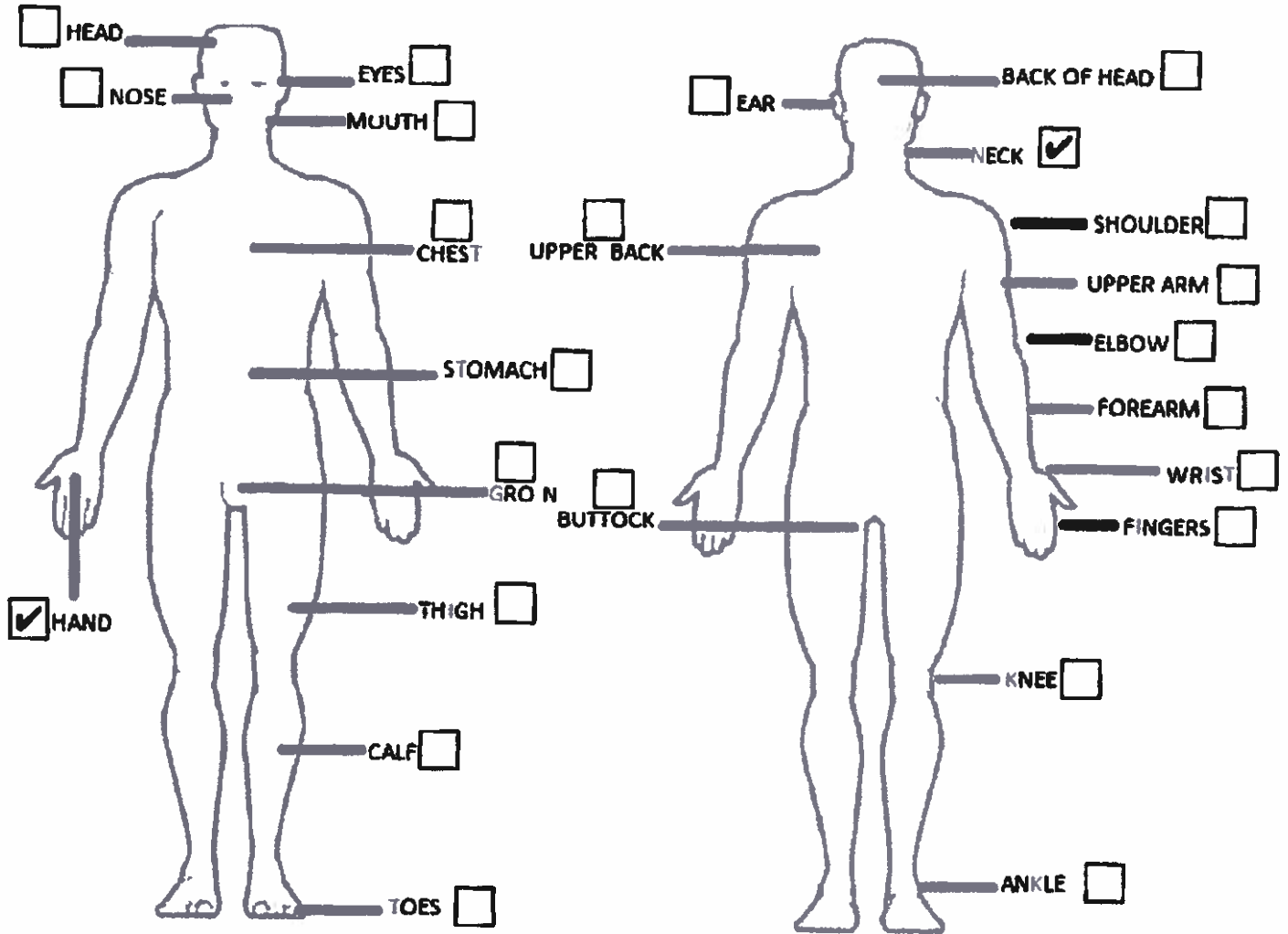

SHE WENT IN THE WARDEN'S OFFICE AND CAME BACK AND SAID, "EVEN DAVID AGREED THAT IT AINT NO BUG". SHE STILL REPLACED THE TRAY FOR ME. I WENT BACK TO CLUSTER #6 AND GAVE I.M B. HODGE HIS TRAY AND TOLD HIM THAT IT WASNT A BUG. I/M B. HODGE REPLIED, " FUCK YOU, I AINT EATING NO BUG. "FUCK WAH YOU THINK." I TOLD I/M B. HODGE TO WATCH HOW U TALKING TO ME PLEASE. HE REPLIED" FUCK YOU YUH CLOWN". AT THIS TIME I WAS LEAVING OUT THE CLUSTER AND I/M NIYONELL LETANG ASKED ME IF HE COULD GET A CUP. I SAID, "OK". WHEN RETURNING TO CLUSTER #6, I ORDERED I/M B. HODGE TO HIS CELL AND I/M B. HODGE REFUSED. I/M B. HODGE STOOD UP IN A BELLIGERENT MANNER. I WENT TO GIVE I/M N. LETANG HIS CUPS AND I APPROACHED I/M B. HODGE TO ESCORT HIM TO HIS CELL. AS I WAS GOING TO ESCORT I/M B. HODGE TO HIS CELL AND HE PUSHED ME IN THE CHEST. I GRABBED HIS HAND AND I/M B. HODGE DUCKED DOWN LOW TO GRAB MY WAIST AREA. I THEN GRABBED I/M B. HODGE IN A NECK HOLD TO STOP HIM FROM PICKING ME UP OFF THE FLOOR. WHILE HOLDING I/M B. HODGE, I TOLD ALL INMATES TO GO TO THIER CELLS. I/M CYMARI FREDERICKS OPENED CELL#2 AND I RELEASED I/M B. HODGE TO HIS CELL AREA AND SECURED HIM. MY RADIO BATTERY WAS DEAD, SO I COULDN'T CALL FOR SECURITY. TCO MENDALI LETTSOME CAME IN THE DAYROOM AREA AND SECURED THE REMAINING INMATES IN THEIR CELLS. I IMMEDIATELY NOTIFIED CHIEF MYRON FREDERICKS AND THE ACTING SUPERVISOR C/O JELANI CHARLESWELL OF THE INCIDENT.

At dinner time it was chicken pate being served for dinner. When I receive my food, I saw a roach on top of the chicken pate. I then turn the officer and told him I have a roach on top of my pate. He say stop lying. The officer was Crooke. I then showed it to everybody because he thought I was lying. Then everybody admit what it was. I then give him the tray and I told him I'm not eating that. He got mad because he didn't want to go back to the kitchen to get me a next plate of food. He then went to the kitchen and brought me back a next plate of food. I sat down at the table after I got my second plate of food from Ofc. Crooke. He told me when he bring back the food, the kitchen staff told him there is no roach in the food. While eating my food I told him I don't want to hear it. I know what I saw. Since I told him that I said I don't want to get in any conflict with you. I got up from the table with my tray in my hand and went to the next side of the cluster area. Ofc. Crooke came to where I was and told me I think that I'm a bad man. I told him that he is not going to do me anything and he walk through the door mad. While leaving, a inmate told him he need two cups of water. While I was at the table, I got up from the seat and he turned to me and told me, if I want something. He then rush me and threw a right hand and then a left had at me. Then I was trying to get away from the officer, but I was in a corner. He then told me why I running come. He then approach me and grab me a flush. He held me in a flush for five minutes as I tried to get away. Then inmate Cymari Fredericks got up from the table and told Ofc. Crooke to lose me. Officer Crooke told inmate Fredericks to tell inmate Benjamin to go in his room. I was put in my room by Officer Crooke while I was in a flush. After the gate was closed, I told Officer Crooke, I pressing charges on you.

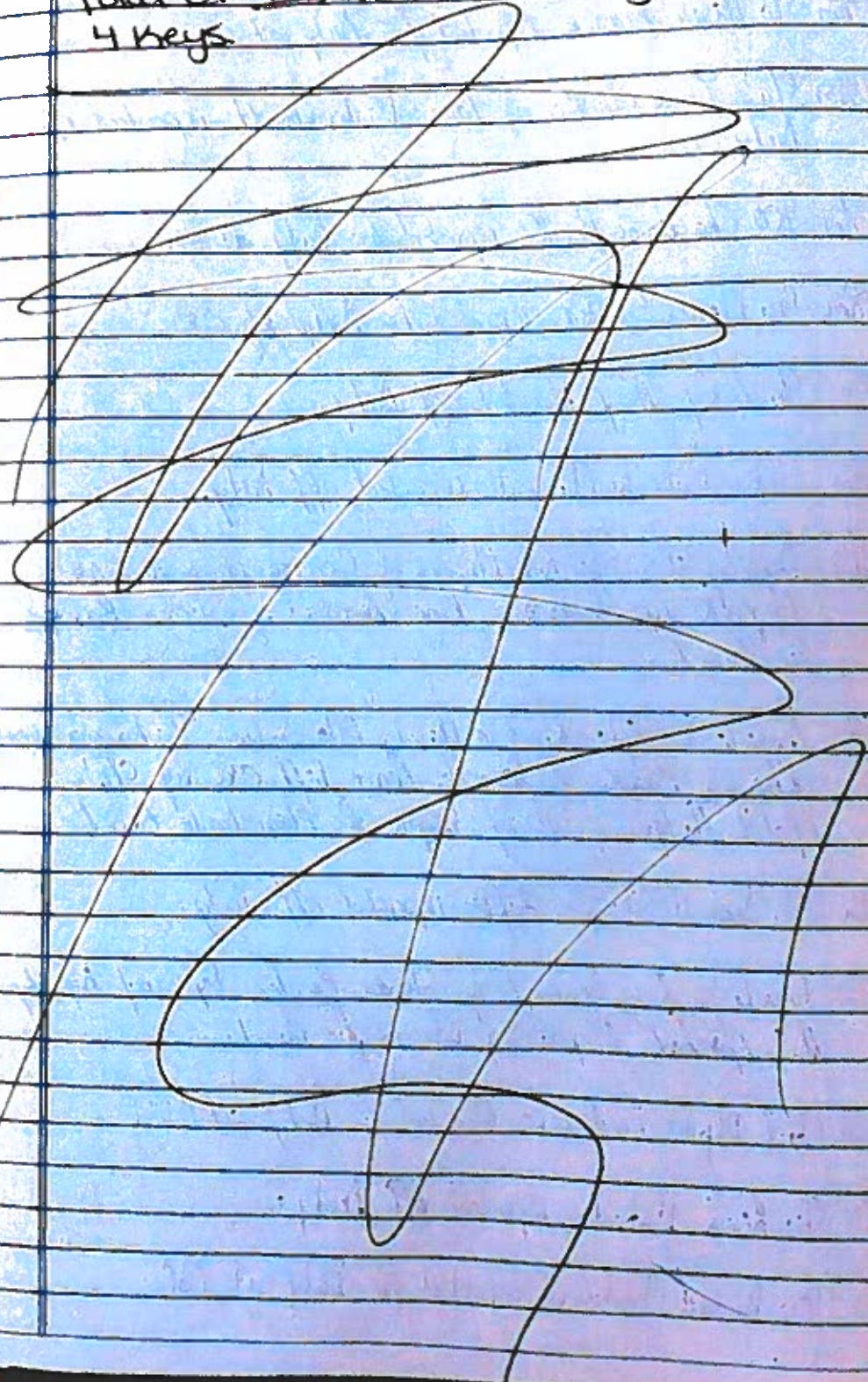
