SUPPLEMENTAL EXPERT AFFIDAVIT OF LETITIA ANNE PEPLAU, PH.D.

I, Letitia Anne Peplau, Ph.D., hereby depose and say as follows:

- 1. I have actual knowledge of the matters stated in this affidavit and could and would testify as to such matters if called as a witness.
- 2. I have already provided an expert affidavit dated May 19, 2011 (my "Original Affidavit") in this litigation. A complete explanation of my professional background, experience, publications, and compensation appears in my Original Affidavit.
- 3. I have been asked to respond to three articles cited in the Memorandum of Law in Support of Intervenor-Defendant's Opposition to Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment and Intervenor-Defendant's Local Rule 56.1 Response to Plaintiff's Statement of Material Facts, filed on August 1, 2011, by Defendant-Intervenor the Bipartisan Legal Advisory Group of the U.S. House of Representatives: (a) Lisa M. Diamond, *New Paradigms for Research on Heterosexual and Sexual Minority Development*, 32 J. Clinical Child & Adolescent Psychol. 492 (2003); (b) Lisa M. Diamond & Ritch C. Savin-Williams, *Explaining Diversity in the Development of Same-Sex Sexuality Among*

Young Women, 56 J. Soc. Issues 297 (2000); and (c) Nigel Dickson et al., Same-Sex Attraction in a Birth Cohort: Prevalence and Persistence in Early Adulthood, 56 Soc. Sci. & Med. 1607 (2003) (together, the "Articles").

- 4. In preparing this affidavit I reviewed the Articles. I am also generally familiar with the scholarship of Lisa M. Diamond, the author of two of the Articles.
- 5. None of the Articles change, in any way, any of the expert opinions I expressed in my Original Affidavit, including my expert opinions that "[s]exual orientation refers to an enduring pattern of emotional, romantic, and/or sexual attractions to men, women, or both sexes"; that sexual orientation is "a multi-faceted phenomenon involving attractions, related behaviors, and identity"; that "[m]ost adults are attracted to and form relationships with members of only one sex"; and that "the significant majority of adults exhibit a consistent and enduring sexual orientation" (Original Affidavit ¶¶ 10, 17).
